Online Services - SystmOnline

You can make an appointment, order repeat medication and view your medical record, online with SystmOnline.

Children's Health

Childhood immunisation and vaccination clinic - held every week on Tuesdays and Thursdays by our Practice Nurses.

Appointments will be sent by the Vaccination & Immunisation Team at Victoria House for parents to attend with their children. Please let us know if you cannot attend and we can rebook your appointment easily.

Travel Vaccinations

We do provide a travel vaccination service. You MUST contact us well in advance of travelling.

You have to attend for an assessment with our nurses first and they may identify vaccinations you need that must be ordered. You may then need another appointment for the nurses to give you the vaccinations.

Not all Travel Vaccinations are free and you may be charged the cost of the vaccines and a fee for administration

Family Planning

A full family planning service is offered by the Practice including the fitting of coils and contraceptive implants. Advice on family planning matters is available from the Doctors during normal surgery. For urgent advice on the morning after pill please telephone Brocklehurst Pharmacy on Willerby Road (Tel No 352075) or Wold Road (Tel No. 572659).

Minor Surgery

Held by Dr Cassim, the practice is fully equipped to undertake a wide range of surgical procedures, providing a convenient option that enables patients to avoid the delays frequently encountered at hospitals.

Chronic Disease Management Clinics

Patient reviews are held annually (to coincide with date of birth) by our Practice Nurses

Home Visiting Team

If you ring for a home visit your request will be reviewed by one of our GPs. They may decide to send a member of our Home Visiting Team to see you. The team is made up of health professionals who can assess your condition and report back to the GPs

Cancer Care Service

Following an initial cancer diagnosis, we aim to provide the continuing care and support that you want. Carol and Christine have knowledge of the support services available.

District Nurses

The District Nursing Teams come into the Practice most days and liaise closely with the doctors, when problems are discussed and treatment plans worked out.

Non-NHS Medical Services

Medical examinations for life assurance, employment purposes, public services vehicle and heavy goods licensing are available by special appointment.

NHS Health Checks

If you are a Hull patient aged 40 to 74 we can offer you an NHS Health Check. Unfortunately we cannot currently offer this service to patients living in the East Ridng

Practice Nurses

The Practice Nursing Team advise on travel immunisation and general health matters. They offer chronic disease management, cervical smears, ear syringing and blood pressure checks, family planning, blood tests, ECG's etc. They also assist the doctors with minor surgery. The Practice Nursing Team is also available for advice on many health related matters - providing an alternative to an appointment with the GP.

Health Visitors

Your Health Visitors are able to advise on general health matters. They are particularly concerned with children below the age of 5 years. They are also available for "crisis" visits. The Health Visitors are now based at the Calvert Health Care Centre, Calvert Lane, Hull.
